



## Evgeny Korolev

*Tennis Professional, ATP Highest ranking #46*

### Synopsis

Born in 1988 in Moscow, Russia. Evgeny Korolev was one of the top rising stars across Russia and later Europe as a junior. Evgeny rose to Junior ETA number 18 by the age of 13. He turned pro in 2005 at the age of 17 where he had instant success winning 3 Futures tournaments across Germany, France and Austria followed by his first major win of a ATP Challenger in Germany. At the age of 18 (2006) he reached Top 100 in the world and was the youngest players in top 100. By 2010 he had reached a top 50 in the world with success at the Australia Open.

### Turning Pro

Turning pro in 2005 at the age of 17 he had instant success that year winning 3 Futures tournaments across Germany, France and Austria followed by his first ATP Challenger tournament win in Germany. This provided him with an impressive win/loss ratio. His success convinced him to play more Challenger tournaments. In 2006 Evgeny made the quarters of the Marseille ATP with wins over the world number 3 Nikolay Davydenko. During his Roland Garros debut he defeated former world number 1, Carlos Moya. Following that he won another ATP Challenger and was runner up in a further ATP Challenger event.

By 2007 Evgeny was a regular playing Grand Slams and ATP tournaments as well as playing Davis Cup for Russia and later Kazakhstan.

Some highlights of Evgeny career between 2007 to 2014 include:

- representing Kazakhstan in Davis Cup 2010 to 2015 - QTR finals each year.
- reaching 3<sup>rd</sup> round Australian Open

- reaching 2<sup>nd</sup> round French Open, Wimbledon, US Open
- 1 ATP final Delray Beach 2009
- 3 ATP Semi finals
- 14 ATP Quarter finals
- 5 ATP Challenger Single Titles and 3 Titles in Doubles.
- 6 ITF Futures Single Titles and 4 Titles in Doubles
- On tour Evgeny had many wins over Top players like: James Blake, Fernando Gonzales, Marat Safin, Nikolay Davydenko, Carlos Moya, Stanislas Wawrinka, Robby Ginepro, Sam Querrey, Thomas Berdych, Fabrice Santoro, Guillermo Canas, Robin Soderling, Dmitry Tursunov, Gaston Gaudio. Has reached his highest ranking of No. 46 after a successful performance at Australian Open 2010 where he defeated Thomas Berdych in 3 straight sets in the second round and end up losing a close match in 5 sets to Fernando Gonzales in the 3<sup>rd</sup> round.
- For many years Evgeny has played Club team tennis in Germany and Switzerland. In the past Evgeny was sponsored by Air Berlin Airlines, Adidas, Nike, Prince Racquets, Carbo4You Nutrition, Luxilon, Solinco Inc and Head Racquets. He played Exhibition Events with top Players like Novak Djokovic, Marat Safin, Andy Murray and more.
- Evgeny was also asked to appear in several commercials and photoshoots for Cosmopolitan Russia, Clio and Rip Curl.
